Ideas from our staff to help students successfully begin their middle school-careers:

Ideas for parents to help their middle schoolers succeed:

- v Visit the school as often as possible to become familiar with the surroundings.
- v Practice organizing your belongings.
- Enjoy your vacation time and rest up to come back to school.
- Work on the multiplication tables for numbers 1-12.
- Practice mental math by estimating and rounding.
- v Read as often as possible—at least a few times a week. It doesn't matter if it's a magazine or Harry Potter—even the dictionary is fine—whatever suits you!
- We as active as possible! Make use of the nice weather by swimming, playing a sport, hiking, or just playing in the backyard.
- Be ready to try new activities!

- Create a study area and plan a routine to help with the completion of daily tasks.
- v Make your home a learning center for your child with sources such as books, word games, and magazines readily available.
- Beat procrastination! Encourage your child to start projects early, breaking larger tasks down into smaller ones.
- v Monitor and reward progress: keep up with your child's progress by reviewing the parent portal on a daily basis, communicating frequently with your child as well as communicating with your child's teachers.
- Make and enjoy meals as a family. The University of Michigan published a study that found the greatest predictor of academic and social success at school to be connectedness of the student to the home. This includes families playing games and sharing meals together.

- v 1 Pump bottle of hand sanitizer


