
### Q1 Did you attend Parent Teacher Conferences this year?



# Q2 This year, we tried to offer more flexibility around the time of day that conference appointments were available. Please rank order your preferred time slots.





## Q4 Would it be helpful if daycare was provided for you during your Parent Teacher Conference?




